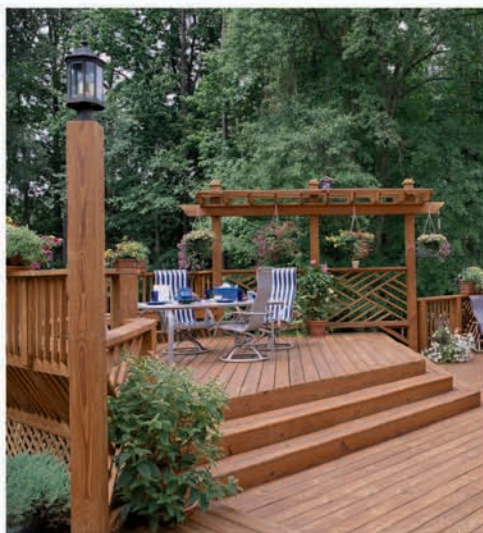

For all of the wonderful characteristics of wood as a building material – natural appearance, ease of construction, economy, and environmental benefits to name a few – some wood will warp. It is not necessary to accept lumber that is warped or discolored or showing effects of moisture. Now, there is Wolmanized® Residential Outdoor® Wood with Stabilizr™ additive, and it has earned the Good Housekeeping Seal.

Suited for decks, fences, walkways, and other backyard projects, this wood is pressure-treated with both an effective preservative and a water repellent. The result is wood that will last for decades – it carries a lifetime limited warranty against termites and fungal decay – and is protected from the time it is treated.

It can be several months from the time wood is pressure-treated until a project is built and coated with a sealant. Typical treated wood has no defense against moisture during that period, and it is usually moisture that causes warping and cracking. However, Stabilizr™ additive is factory-applied as part of the pressure-treatment – it penetrates down to the heartwood.

When wood gets wet, it swells; as it dries, wood shrinks. This causes stresses within the wood. Stabilizr™ additive minimizes this tendency by slowing the rate at which lumber absorbs and releases moisture. Wood looks better, with less cracking and warping. The results are more attractive projects, easier construction, less maintenance, and fewer exchanges.

## Is maintenance ever necessary?

All decking products require occasional care. The Stabilizr™ additive will remain within the wood for a long time, but the wood's surface is subject to sunshine, rain, and foot traffic. For maximum surface protection of treated wood, apply a topical water repellent to conspicuous lumber when your project is completed, and repeat this every year or two thereafter. With periodic surface coating, your project will look good for years.

## Can I paint or stain it?

Yes. For best results, oil-based or penetrating latex stains are recommended. Use the same guidelines that coatings manufacturers recommend for painting or staining regular treated wood. For a water-based product, wait at least six months before applying.

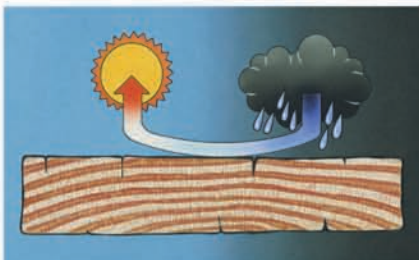
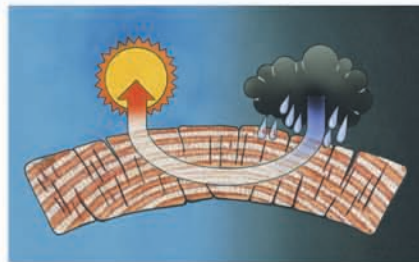


Wood Treated Right™
